DARTH HOLDER INSTALLATION/REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

Contents:

- High-tech spherical elastomeric retention device (a.k.a. Racquetball)
- Darth bracket
- Two removable and adjustable springs
- Carrying case

Installation:



1. Insert bracket into "change" cubby above door sill. Be sure that the lower "v" bend sits inside the cubby (figure a).
2. Fit racquetball to center of bracket so that ball sits in cubby (figure a). Then, using both hands, lift bracket "v" up and over rim of cubby pocket (figure b) and into position.
3. Roll ball all the way back into place so that the ball cannot move back any further (figure c).

Removal:

1. Using both hands, lift bracket at neck and pull "v" bend up and over cubby opening at base (opposite of figure b). Release bracket so that it sits on sill (figure a).
2. Remove racquetball.
3. Place in storage bag for your next drink adventure.

Note for the nimble: Once the cup is in, it won't be in the way of ingress/egress.

Note on cup sizes and spring adjustment: For the majority of cups, the spring settings pre-installed on the holder will work. For Red Bull fans, the shortened, inner mounts are best. For the really big cups, remove the springs entirely. Springs are easily removed by pushing down on the spring near the hole, and lifting out spring end. Refitting is just as easy!
